Dear Principal,

Further, all the Principals are requested to create exclusive WhatsApp group of the Class teachers of their school, for dissemination of information received in this regard as well as to collect the field level feedback from the parents and students. The concerned Class teachers, in turn, will disseminate this information further to their students and parents through respective Whatsapp groups.
- 4. As a first step, you are requested to conduct an online (Webinar) or offline meeting ensuring Covid-19 guidelines with all the teachers and convey the campaign details and to create awareness regarding appropriate behaviour in view of the pandemic.
- 5. The details like Number of Teachers, Number of Students, Number of Parents covered may be compiled in respect of your school and shared in WhatsApp group "to be created by the City Coordinator (or any other method like Google Forms etc. for collection of information) for compilation and transmission to Regional Officer, CBSE, Bengaluru.
- 6. A copy of the letter dated 01/10/2020 from Hon'ble Secretary, CBSE, along with Date-wise Action Plan and PPT on the campaign, is attached for further necessary action.
- 7. Your active participation shall make this significant campaign successful for ensuring appropriate Public Health response to Covid-19 which would benefit the society, at large.
